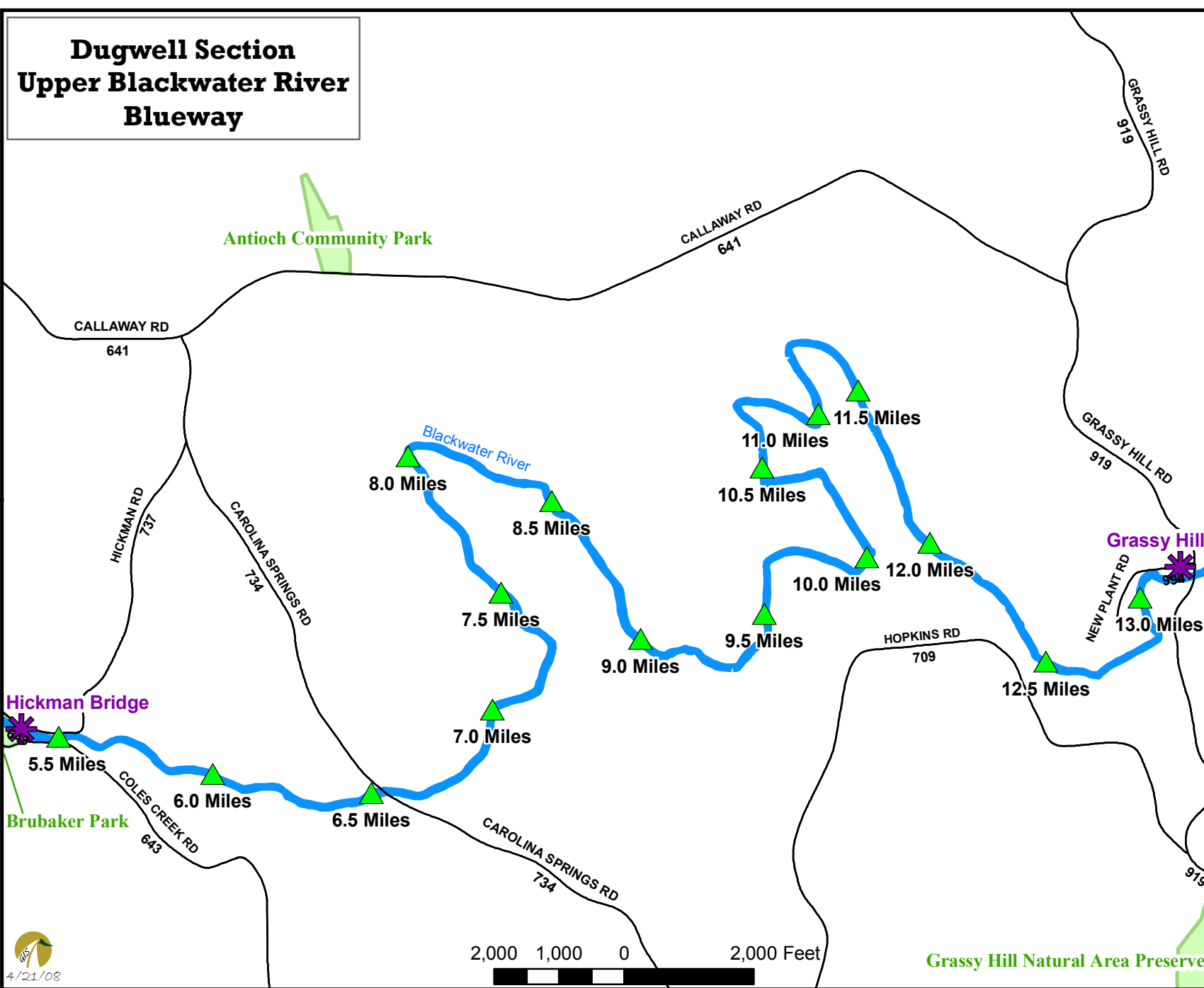


Dugwell Section Upper Blackwater River Blueway



General Information

Running from Brubaker Park to Grassy Hill Road, this eight mile run is ideal for families and novice paddlers. Small riffles and a couple of farm fords provide interest along the route. Remarkably wild, paddlers will encounter few signs of habitation until the take out at CTS&I Millworks. Look for a minimum reading of 2.3 feet on the Rocky Mount Blackwater River USGS gauge before attempting this section. Float time is about four hours in normal water conditions. Small sunfish can be caught year round on this stretch.

DIRECTIONS FROM ROANOKE(220N): To Take Out: Take first Rocky Mount Exit(Buisness 220 S). Take right at first light onto Grassy Hill Rd. and continue two miles. After crossing the Blackwater River take the first left (New Plant Rd.). Must park in front of the gate. To Put In: Take a left onto Grassy Hill Rd. Take a left onto Callaway Rd. Continue three miles and take a left on Carolina Springs Rd. Take the first right onto Hickman Rd. Continue to the Iron Bridge and take a left. Turn right on Deyerle Knob Rd. Brubaker park will be on right.

DIRECTIONS FROM MARTINSVILLE/ROCKY MOUNT(220S): To Take Out: Take third Rocky Mount Exit (Business 220 S). Take left at stop sign. Take first right on Grassy Hill Rd. Follow directions above.
