

The Scout Campout At The Jakes Event (Free Event)*

Dates:

Boy Scout Troops: Friday, September 10 & Saturday, September 11

Cub Scout Packs: Saturday Sept 11(set up only after the event: approx 3pm)

- All Scout guidelines must be closely adhered to during this event.
- Fax in a tour permit to the Council Office.
- Camp only in the designated areas for your scout unit.
- Please remember we are there as a guest of the Franklin County Longbeards Association. Whose main concern is to see the JAKES Event be a great success. If in the event we end up setting up a camp in the wrong area, please show Scout spirit and move to the designated areas if asked.
- If there is no fire ban law in effect, each unit may have a maximum of one container fire off the ground. There must be an air space between the ground and the container to prevent ground scorching. (unless in the graveled area) **ABSOLUTELY NO FIRE PITS** even if you think you have permission and intend to repair the site. No fires are ever to be left unattended by an adult. Do not leave the ashes at the park, douse them, and take them out with you. Violators may have to deal with park and county authorities!
- Likewise, do not put large amounts of your trash in the containers in the parks. Take your trash to the dumpsters at the top of the hill on the way out. The Jakes people are responsible for their trash; we must be responsible for ours. The park returns to the public in the afternoon therefore, it needs to look as pristine as ever for public use.
- No driving on the grass and park in the parking lots only.
- Don't forget to thank the Jakes instructors and coordinators every chance you get!

Camp schedule:

3pm- 8pm: This time is to be planned, supervised and structured by the individual unit's. Take advantage of this golden opportunity, for your outdoor advancement needs. (belt loops, activity pins, "go see-its" , hiking trails for plant and tree identification and the *Mighty Pigg* for fishing. and the playground for the younger folk.) Don't forget dinner during this time!

10:30: All Quiet (including adults!)

7:30 am: Scout is Reverent: Sunrise service (Place TBA)

8:00 am: camp closing
